

## 2 Suspects Wanted For Slaying Of Northridge Man

*(CBS) NORTHRIDGE* Two 18-year-old suspects were identified Friday in the stabbing of a 33-year-old Northridge man who was found dead in a Porter Ranch park.

Police responded to LimeKiln Canyon Park in Porter Ranch at 1 p.m. Sunday and found Daniel Edward Koch stabbed to death in a creek.

Police said the two suspects -- Quinn Marez and Justin Thalheimer -- were acquaintances of the victim.

Koch got into an argument with the two men, one of whom pulled out a knife and stabbed him, police said. The two suspects then fled the scene, LAPD Detective Michael Fesperman said.
